



Eagle One Coach Presents

Over half a century old, the Canadian Tulip Festival in Ottawa celebrate international friendship and the return of spring as millions of colourful flowers bloom in parks and gardens across the Capital. Ottawa's tulip heritage is the result of a 1945 gift to Ottawa from Princess Juliana of the Netherlands in thanks for the safe haven the city provided the Dutch Royal Family during the Second World and the role Canadian troops played in liberating Holland during that conflict.

The Festival also presents entertainment, family activities and an international pavilion featuring foods and heritage presentations by countries from around the world.

Trip Overview

Day One:

We'll depart early this morning on a scenic drive through New Hampshire and Vermont. After lunch, we'll pick up our tour guide who will be with us for the next four days at Crown Point, NY. We'll enter Canada at Cornwall, ON where everyone must present a valid passport or passport ID card. An early evening check in will be followed by dinner at the hotel. Remainder of evening is at your leisure.

Day Two:

A Breakfast Buffet is included at the hotel. After breakfast, it's off to "tiptoe through the tulips" at Dow's Lake. Always a popular destination at Commissioner's Park. Springtime sees over one million tulips in more than 50 varieties bring the National Capital Commission's (NCC) flower beds to life. The highest concentration in the region, some 300,000, can be found in Commissioner's Park during the festival. Visit the NCC's Tulip Legacy Exhibit at Dow's Lake and discover the fascinating details of events leading to the "Gift of Tulips." Then follow the Tulip Route as it winds its way along the canal. ****Note:** This is a fair amount of leisurely walking at your own pace. Benches are everywhere to stop and enjoy the beauty of the tulips.

This afternoon, visit the Musee du Civilization in Gatineau. See the world's largest collection of totem poles and a huge exhibit on Amerindians of Canada. Tulip beds abound as you enjoy lunch on your own overlooking the Saint Lawrence River from the museum's café.

After lunch, tour the magnificent building of the seat of Canadian Government at Parliament. A security check is required here.

After returning to your hotel, you may wish to visit Lac Leamy Casino and enjoy dinner on your own at one of their many restaurants or relax with dinner on your own at the hotel and enjoy the lounge.

Day Three:

After a Buffet Breakfast at the hotel, we'll depart with a local step on guide for a tour of the Capital of Canada including Rideau Hall, Notre Dame Basilica, Rideau Canal and lots more. Lunch will be on your own as you stroll the cobblestone streets and boutiques of Old Ottawa in By Ward Market.

After lunch we continue on to Parc Omega at Montebello. Enjoy an enchanting safari style tour on an old school bus where each passenger is given a 2 pound bag of carrots for personalized feeding of the wild life. See Wapiti's, Elk, Moose, Bear, Wolves, Buffalo, Red Deer, Alpine Ibis, Wild Boar and Beaver.

After the safari, we'll end up at Chateau Montebello where the staff will take us on a guide tour of the hotel - a most incredible Fairmont property. Once a hunting lodge for Canada's rich and famous, now an exclusive hotel whose lobby boasts a five sided, two story fire place. We'll enjoy dinner in the exquisite dining hall overlooking 65,000 acres of nature preserve. After dinner, return to the hotel and remainder of evening is free.

Day Four:

After a Buffet Breakfast at the hotel, we'll check out and depart for home. Remember, passports are required to re enter the US. We'll bid farewell to our Hayfield Tours tour director at Crown Point, NY and anticipate an early evening arrival home with many fond memories of our Canadian getaway.
